






These are the updated *FIRST logos*. Do not use any past versions of this logo.


FIRST should always be in both capitals and italics. Refer to FIRST programs as following:



Our color palette consists of three colors: Charger Green, Charger Yellow, and Dark Gray. Specific color values and codes are provided.

The colors indicated should be used in all team material whether physical or digital.

Avoid altering the colors. Try to use these exact colors if possible.

TYPOGRAPHY

Montserrat is our primary font. It should be used in body text of all documents, publications, and our website.

Body text should have some spacing between lines and space after a paragraph. Avoid using Montserrat in sizes smaller than 9pt.

When using a registered trademark symbol, the symbol should be in superscript if possible.

Montserrat is available for free to download and install online. If you cannot install Monterrat, substitute with Verdana or Bahnschrift.
